Please accept my sincere gratitude for reviewing the attached proposal to enhance our Master of Physician Assistant Studies Program. As you are aware, Mississippi State University is proud to have the first PA program at a Mississippi Institution of Higher Learning. This program aligns well with our Land Grant mission of making a significant difference in bettering the lives of Mississippians through addressing health disparity.

In addition to supplying more practitioners for one of the nation's most underserved states, we will also be improving earning potential for those who complete our program. US News and World Report recently ranked the PA profession at the top of the list in three categories: Best Jobs, Best STEM Jobs, and Best Health Care Jobs. The average starting salary for Physician Assistants is around \$100,000 per year, which will undoubtedly impact tax revenue in the state. Furthermore, it will increasingly enhance Mississippi State University's ranking as the state's leading return on educational investment as cited by SmartAsset. In short, this is a safe investment with an assured return.

Finally, I don't think a town in Mississippi would be more supportive of this emerging program than Meridian. As demonstrated in attached letters, we have the overwhelming support of a thriving medical community. Additionally, local donors and foundations pledged more than \$1 million in startup funds to get this program off the ground, which was combined with a match from the university. I have no doubt in our ability to secure matching funds for this project in the same way.
