I am requesting funding for the Bozeman-Reunion Interconnectivity System project in Madison County for Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Madison County, Mississippi, located at 125 West North Street, Canton, Mississippi, 39046. The funding would be used for the construction of Bozeman Road, which is a primary and critical element of the Bozeman-Reunion Crossing Interconnectivity System. Bozeman Road runs north-south from Mississippi Highway 463 to Gluckstadt Road. The scope of the work would include widening the existing road to a four-lane boulevard section from MS 463 to Gluckstadt Road with a 10-foot Multi-Use Trail from MS 463 to Gluckstadt Road. The road improvements would result in significant safety enhancements for the motoring public through reductions in congestion on local arterials and on I-55, resulting in fewer traffic accidents.
